Bid Cycle #3 will run from 6-18-11 to 9-27-11 and be processed as follows:

Posted for Review Tue. 5-31-11

ALL BIDS MUST BE SUBMITTED NO LATER THAN 0800 ON 6-05-11

List more than one option or your desire to go open board; writing “call me” is not acceptable. This includes day off choices for Full Time drivers choosing to go open board.

Failure to submit PRIOR to 6-05-11 at 0800 will indicate that you wish to go “open board”. Any bid submitted after this deadline and prior to completion of the process will be reviewed and awarded based on the time of submission after those that were submitted on time as outlined above. If it becomes necessary to contact you, we will call your Nextel PTT (if you are on duty) or your cell. You will need to respond within 30 minutes or we move on to the next person, with no bump privileges allowed. (An exception to this rule is that if you are on duty at the time you are called, you will be allowed time to respond during your next break.)

Please submit your bid or intent to bid on or before the listed dates so that we can begin assigning the bids at 0800. We will call you if your request is not available, so please make sure you are available to respond to our calls. Additionally, contract bids have been packaged in order to satisfy customer requirements and are in accordance with CBA Article 9 – 9.02 b “The Employer will determine which services must be bid in blocks and when mandatory hour requirements can be waived.”

You may bid at either office (Seattle or Everett) and the two offices will coordinate audit and bid awards.
